RFA Quarterly Report Nov/Dec/Jan 2023-2024

Details: During this quarterly reporting period the FIU responded to numerous incidents. This data encompasses the months of November, December 2023 and January 2024.

The FIU conducted a total of 145 investigations, which included 79 structure fires, 30 vehicle fires, 4 vegetation fires, and 32 trash/dumpster/other type fires/follow-ups responses.

There were 11 canceled responses, 10 arrests reported, and 0 fatal fire incidents.

Breaking down the fires further, out of 145 investigations there were 47 Arsons, 59 Accidental, and 23 Undetermined caused fires.

Fire Communications Report March 7th, 2024

The Fire Communications Branch of the Stanislaus County Fire Authority is dedicated to assisting member agencies in providing communications assistance, direction, and training of the communications systems within Stanislaus County.

CAD / MDC

We are continuing to support the MDC computers and work with agencies as they have needs with either CAD or their Mobile Data Computers. Over the past several months, we have been involved in CAD discussions with several CAD vendors and SR911 is actively pursuing a replacement CAD system.

Zoll FireRMS

Issues within the Zoll FireRMS application have been resolved. Over the past month, we have worked with Westport Fire to get their system back online and operational. We updated all their equipment to match the new apparatus numbering convention and SR911 was able to reprocess data to get reports that were missed and ensure that they would continue to get their data auto-populated after the upgrade as well.

Radio Reprogramming

We are aware that there will be a new published frequency list from Cal OES/ FireScope. We have been actively monitoring, the last one was published in April of 2023. Once the updated listing is posted, we will update all our codeplugs and work to reprogram all radios within the county that are supported with the latest programming.

Oracle CAD Project

We are continuing discussions with Oracle and have been working to answer their questions as they come up. We expect to have more information on the Oracle project in the near future.

Phoenix G2 Installation

The USDD Phoenix G2 Fire Station Alerting System has been installed at Patterson Fire. We are still awaiting a quote from our vendor to install two Cradlepoint modems (already purchased), one at each Patterson Station, which will get us the connectivity back to SR911 to allow the systems to go live. We have solicited the vendor several times and are awaiting a response. Unfortunately, with a system like this there is a very limited number of vendors that will perform the work that needs to be completed in our area.

6.3 RFTC/MJC Fire Technology Program and EMS Program – Presented by Chief Jelinek (digital copy attached)

- MST/MJC partnership to remain a regional resource. The structure is a good foundation and other community colleges are looking at it to adopt to their programs.
- Modesto Fire Department's Chief Officer is available at no charge
- Using the 300 Series for training
- This relationship brings: executive team/training for EMS/apparatus/fleet/props
- Moving forward it would be beneficial and efficient for it to be ran like a fire department, fundamentally, maintenance, pro-active and knowledge
- Assisting students with connecting from education to vocational, not wasting additional time with duplicating training that can last up to fourteen weeks or more. A more efficient transition from academy to department.
- Omnibus Bill: "Lift up and expand RFTC", replace props, establish paramedic training, state training, support MST training tower
- Scholarships
- Further discussion regarding Financial Aid, there is no aid available for the academy only for MJC courses. The fees for the Academy for gear, etc. is approximately \$4,500
- Discussion on the engines/tools/equipment be used for the Volunteer Academy and the MOU does not allow now, but it will be considered and discussed. Station #17 tower is available to the volunteer agencies, upon scheduling.

6.4 Consideration for approval for funding requested for Western Stanislaus County Water Rescue Program – Presented by Chief Frye (digital copy attached)

Since 2008 Patterson Fire has responded to 28 calls, 18 water rescue related and 10 for water search and rescue (only 4 were for the City of Patterson). At the present time they have a 2019 boat and a Ford Expedition used for towing, which limits their ability to rescue where needed and the equipment is outdated and needs maintenance/repairs. There are issues with launching in remote areas, they would like to purchase an inflatable boat, a double decker trailer, a 4x4 F250 Ford truck – package total: approximately \$210,000.

The City of Patterson currently funds the project but the majority of the time it is used by other agencies in the county. They are proposing that the RFA purchase the equipment and the City will fund personnel. It was discussed that there did not seem to be a need for a complex unit but maybe additional training on longline. Chief Parnell stated that there is not a problem scheduling Longline training as long as there is adequate participation. Chief Passalacqua offered to have Woodland Avenue help replace the current motor.

Motion made to be put on upcoming agenda for consideration in the 2025 Business Plan. Motion by: Chief Passalacqua Seconded by: Chief Wise. Motion passed by 16 yes/1 no roll call votes.

History of Volunteer Station Alerting

- Typically, Volunteer Fire Departments (VFD) have used two tone paging.
- Some stations may have an amplified base and some sort of external speaker attached to a base pager.
- Hearing the call within is dependant upon being in close proximity to the amplified base/pager.
- No station integration has taken place to automate any sort of station routines with these systems.

Requirements of the Station Alerting System

- Have antenna placed at the optimum location to get best alerting possible.
- System will provide audio alerting.
- System will provide visual alerting (i.e. light activation/flashing light/etc).
- System will have capability of integrating and shutting off appliances (i.e. station oven, etc).
- System will have a battery backup (UPS). This will power the radio, amplifier, and the speaker/lights.
- System will have Day/Night mode switches to change from daytime monitoring to nighttime, only opening the audio when a call is received.

Requirements of the Station Alerting System (continued)

- System shall be installed using proper construction techniques.
- All speakers that are used in apparatus bays and non climate-controlled areas are to be weather/moisture resistant design to ensure long life.
- Systems shall be installed in an NFPA compliant manner.

Goals of VFD Station Alerting Project

- Provide reliable two tone alerting within the fire station.
- Provide the best possible radio coverage and alerting.
- Ensure that systems are in place with speakers in the appropriate areas...sleeping areas, day areas, apparatus bays, etc.
- Ensure that systems are able to visually and audibly alert personnel of calls.
- Ensure that stations are using either a pager device or a mobile radio device to alert with their calls.

- Request for Quotation to be submitted to vendors on January 3rd, 2024.
- There will be a pre-quotation vendor conference on January 9th.
- The deadline for receipt of quotations is February 5th, 2024.
- Review quotations and award a vendor the project.
- Installations to begin in first quarter of 2024.

The Patterson Fire Department is the only 24/7/365 career staffed fire department in Western Stanislaus County and the only West Stanislaus agency with a water rescue program to include SWR trained personnel, a rescue boat, tow vehicle, ppe, and equipment to affect a SWR in area waterways. Since December 5, 2008 (15 years), the department has responded to approximately 28 Water rescue incidents (recorded in RMS under Code 363 -Swift Water Rescue and 342-Search for Person in Water). Other incidents may have occurred, but they have not been reported. Of the approximately 28 incidents, only 4 actually occurred in the Patterson city limits and were all on or in the Delta Mendota Canal.

The only waterways in the City of Patterson are segments of the California Aqueduct, Delta-Mendota Canal (DMC), a small residential lake in a gated subdivision, and a couple of seasonal creeks (Del Puerto & Salado). To date and as far as I'm aware, there has yet to be a water rescue incident in the residential lake or the segments of the seasonal creeks that that could flow through Patterson. The 4 responses to the DMC were for searches/body recoveries. The DMC and the Aqueduct are not suitable for launching a boat or deploying rescue swimmers. Most rescues/recoveries on the DMC/Aqueduct are made by using throw bags, tools, or deploying ladders from the flow control gates. Any other recovery would be performed by the S.O. Dive Team.

The current water rescue program includes a 2019 Rigid Hull Inflatable Boat with a 60 hp Evinrude with propeller shroud and an older model Ford Expedition. The current boat with its V-hull configuration does not provide the maneuverability to deploy in areas without boat ramps. Additionally, both the boat and the two vehicles often have mechanical/electrical issues and currently the boat is out of service.

At this point, the PFD has reached the point as to whether we will continue to fund a program that is predominantly used outside of the Patterson response area. In order for the PFD to continue to provide human resources to respond to SWR incidents outside of the City, we will need to improve the SWR equipment to continue providing this service to our neighboring agencies.

Ideally, we would like to utilize a 2-Boat model for the SWR program. We are proposing the RFA provide funding to purchase a One Boat R-One Series Aluminum flat bottom hull boat with a 40 hp Mercury Jet. We also would like to add a 14' Inflatable boat R One iSeries 430-R with a 25 hp Mercury Jet that can be carried to streams and remote waterways not accessible with the trailer/two vehicle. Additionally, the department is in need of a reliable tow vehicle and recommends purchasing a ¾ - 1 ton pick up truck to haul the trailer, equipment, and personnel. The total price for all items is approximately \$210,336.

Ford F250 4x4 crew cab: \$79,120

Radio and Lighting Package: \$49,327

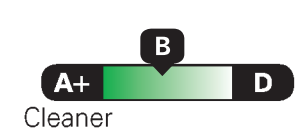

4.1 Consideration for approval of funding for: MST Hazmat Materials/Tech Rescue Team Support, presented by City of Modesto Fire

A PowerPoint presentation was given by Chief Bartley with an overview of MST Hazmat Materials/Tech Rescue and their relationship with the county.

Chief Wise further explained what they offered as an incident management team and that they have MOU's with several agencies and are willing to have more agreements with agencies or individuals who are interested.

Chief Parnell asked what the number of HazMat and Tech Specialist calls were made outside of district. The reply was that they are listed in the quarterly reports, but they did not know figures to offer at the meeting. Chief Frye asked why there was a need to have a Special Meeting for this item and he was informed that it was a previous agenda item but had not been addressed in time prior to the expiration of the current contract, which will expire on February 1, 2024.

Chief Tietjen explained an incident they used the Hazmat team that involved a roll over propane truck and included over eighteen hours of mitigation. He also added that a district may not feel they would use the team but if the time does come, they will be thankful that they have that security.

A question was presented as to what the call down order was? Flow chart? Chief Bartley responded that to start by calling Station 4 and they may be able answer your questions, direct you to the appropriate contact or they will respond, if necessary. Also, dispatch can be called, they have them built into the system.

Chief Parnell asked for approval of the three-year contract costing RFA \$250,000 annually. He asked if any were opposed to the agreement, none were opposed, passed unanimously by representatives.
