Dear Ms. Ardis:

We have received documentation from the City of Oakdale, Valley Home Joint School District, and the Hickman Community Charter District, California confirming their adoption of the *Stanislaus County Multi-Jurisdictional Plan*. These jurisdictions are now in compliance with the planning requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000.

The *Stanislaus County Multi-Jurisdictional Plan* is valid for five years from the approval date, July 20, 2011, for all approved participants. The plan must be reviewed, updated and submitted to FEMA Region IX for approval at least once every five years. An updated list of the current status of participating jurisdictions is enclosed with this letter.

The approval of this plan ensures the City of Oakdale, Valley Home Joint School District, and the Hickman Community Charter District's continued eligibility for project grants under FEMA's hazard mitigation assistance programs, including Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, Pre-Disaster Mitigation, Flood Mitigation Assistance and Severe Repetitive Loss grant programs. All requests for funding, however, will be evaluated individually according to the specific eligibility, and other requirements of the particular program under which applications are submitted. Approved mitigation plans are eligible for points under the National Flood Insurance Program's Community Rating System (CRS).
